Midwestern Career College's **Associate of Applied Science** (AAS) degree program in **Diagnostic Medical Sonography** prepares students for entry-level positions in the diagnostic medical sonography field with general education, applied knowledge, technical skills, and work habits, including:

- monitoring, adjustment, and operation of ultrasound equipment
- observation and care for patients throughout examinations
- summarization of technical data to present to physicians

Externship is provided through this program and is an integral part of career developing and placement.

What Is Sonography?

Diagnostic medical sonography utilizes high-frequency sound waves that produce images of organs, tissues and blood flow inside the body that help doctors diagnose patient illness.

Sonographers typically work closely with patients and radiologists in health-care settings, including hospitals, diagnostic medical centers, mobile ultrasound companies, medical clinics, and physician's offices.

- a four-year degree prior to the start of this

- one year of work experience in the sonography field from the date of graduation of this program

Students of our program are eligible for a 380-clock-hour externship at one of our affiliated hospitals or medical centers. Clinical externships provide a unique opportunity for a real-life, hands-on patientcare experience. Career Outlook

Medical sonographers are in demand. Strong employment growth of 26% is projected over the next decade, much faster than the average for all occupations, according to the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics.
