U.S. TAX QUESTIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

WHEN SHOULD I FILE MY TAXES AND SUBMIT MY TAX Forms?

File your taxes as soon as possible! The deadline to submit your taxes this year is April 17, 2018.

I'M AN F-1 INTERNATIONAL STUDENT AND I DID NOT WORK LAST YEAR. DO I NEED TO FILE TAXES IN THE U.S.?

Students that did not work in the U.S. in 2017 need to complete Form 8843.

SHOULD I COMPLETE ALL PARTS OF THE FORM 8843?

International students should complete the top section, Part I, and Part III of Form 8843.



CAN I EMAIL THE FORMS?

No. You must download the forms, print them out, and send the forms by mail. Stamps and envelopes are available at your local U.S. post office and most major grocery stores and pharmacies.
