What is dialysis?

Dialysis consists of filtering blood to remove waste and then reintroducing the blood back into the circulatory system. The goal of treatment is to help patients with end-stage renal diseases (ESRD) live healthy, active lives.

- National Certified Phlebotomy Technician (NCPT) from the National Center for Competency Testing (NCCT)
- Registered Phlebotomy Technician (RPT) from American Medical Technologists (AMT), after completion of 50 venipunctures and 10 skin punctures, which may require additional clinical experience after program completion

There is no mandatory requirement that dialysis technologists hold a license in the states of Illinois, Wisconsin or Indiana to practice. However, professional certification is generally required to qualify for employment in most clinical settings.
