

ARP ACT REPORTING – HEERF III

4th Quarter Fund Report

This report is being provided on January 5, 2022

Midwestern Career College (OPE ID: 04139000) received education stabilization funds under section 2003 (a)(4) of ARP. This Fund Report applies to the student funds received under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (ARP) that is designated exclusively for emergency financial aid grants to students.

The institution will receive these funds and will distribute them in accordance with the ARP.

1. The institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the ARP (a)(4) program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
2. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the ARP (a)(4) program is \$232,162.
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the ARP (a)(4) program as of the date of submission is \$116,081.
4. The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the ARP (a)(4) program is 450.
5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the ARP (a)(4) program is 413.
6. To be eligible to receive HEERF III grants, students must have met the following criteria:
 - a. have incurred expenses for any component of your cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or childcare; and
 - b. be actively enrolled with Midwestern Career College at the time of grant distribution; and
 - c. complete and electronically submit the ARP HIGHER EDUCATION EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND ATTESTATION FORM.
 - d. MCC will prioritize domestic students and those with exceptional need per Department of Education guidance.

The amount a financial aid student will receive will be based on the total number of applicants and their EFC from the most recent FAFSA on File. We will allocate 9% to 16% of the funds for non-Domestic students and distribute the funds evenly between all the non-Domestic student applicants.

7. Eligible students received the below communication providing details and instructions regarding HEERF III emergency financial aid grants:

Actively enrolled students at Midwestern Career College, may be eligible for an emergency financial aid grant as part of the American Rescue Plan's (ARP) Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) program. MCC was awarded \$232,162 which will be disbursed to students, prioritizing exceptional need.

Emergency financial aid grants may be used by students for any component of their cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or childcare. Students determine how they may use their emergency financial aid grant within the allowable uses.
